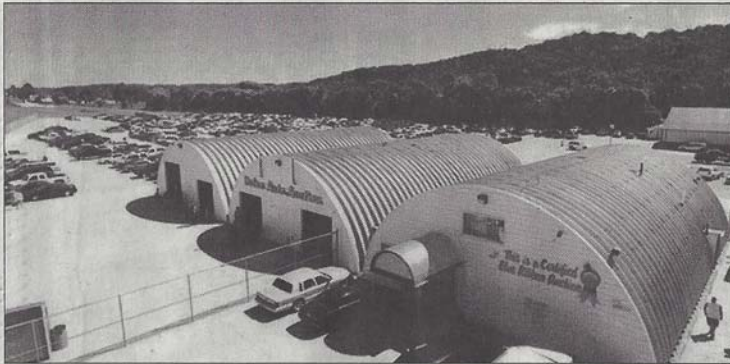

## Value Auto Auction offers big selection for car dealers across the region

### Company has raised more than \$15k for Wounded Warrior and Autism

Located on State Route 93 just outside Crooksville, Value Auto Auction has been working on the concept that all dealerships should be treated equally since Robert and Christopher Fahey first established the company in 2004.

Since then the Fahey's have expanded their staging area to three times its original size, maintained a wash and detailing facility, and integrated a fully functional online auction.

Value Auto Auction is the lone, dealer only, weekly auto auction in the area and the upgrades to the facility have totaled more than \$350,000. The company is also one of the larger employers in Perry County with over 100 employees including part

time drivers.

Value Auto Auction is in a location that is central to several large city markets, located just 60 miles from Columbus, 30 Miles from Lancaster and Newark, 35 miles from Marietta and 15 miles from Zanesville. Value Auto Auction also serves West Virginia and as far south as Charleston. Value Auto Auction continues to improve and enhance the buyer and seller experience with their weekly auto auction known as "The Thursday Sale" the real dealer's

auction. The Thursday Sale begins at 10:30 a.m. with financial institution's repossessions and continues, averaging over 500 units available on a weekly basis; typically 65% from new car dealer trades.

The Thursday Sale began in 2004 with one lane and 70 units, and has grown to 4 lanes averaging over 500 units re-marketed per sale, making Value Auto Auction the fastest growing weekly auction in the Midwest.

Additionally, the auction sponsors two fundraising events per year, Wounded Warrior and Autism, raising more than \$15,000.
